In school we are learning:

We will be looking at clothing and how we wash these clothes.

We will look at clothing and washing tags.
We will also learn how the washing
machine works and we will be able to
complete our own load of washing too.

Home learning opportunities:

When you are doing the washing get your child to help with the washing. They can help sort the washing or put the washing into them washing machine. You could also get them to watch how this is done and talk to them about what you do and why you keep your clothes clean.

In school we are learning:

Gymnastics. We will be learning the 5 key gymnastics shapes (tuck, pike, straight, straddle, star). We will also look at different types of rolls and balances. We will look to put these into a routine.

Home learning opportunities:

When at home you can practise the gymnastics shapes at home. You can also do these whilst doing physio or stretches.

Discovery Days
