











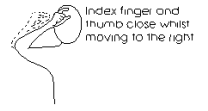


Our Learning Newsletter: Autumn 2

<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About nursery rhymes and poems, focusing on Humpty Dumpty.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy nursery rhymes? Can they sing or dance along? Which ones are their favourite? Sing some together, do the actions!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About size and weight. We will be exploring heavy and light, big and small, and long and short.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Can your child explore different sizes and weights of household objects? Can they say which one is heavier/bigger/longer?</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About healthy eating and a balanced diet. We will be exploring foods and talking about what we need to eat to stay healthy. We will also be discussing the importance of exercise.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy exploring different foods, even if it is only with their hands initially? What are your child's favourite foods, can they say why? Do some physical activity together!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About making sound and music with technology.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Do you have technology at home that makes sound or music? Are there apps on the iPad where they can produce sound? If not, are there any other ways to produce music without instruments, e.g. pots and pans, rice shaker?</p>
 <p style="text-align: center;">Life Skills</p>  <p style="font-size: small; text-align: center;">Hands make a path along forward movement</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;">PE</p>  <p style="font-size: small; text-align: center;">Hands pull apart respect</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: Our theme this half term is dressing skills. Autumn gives us opportunities to dress up, make hats and attempt fastenings.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Go on; tackle those annoying buttons, zips and even laces. They may not succeed at first but they will get there in the end.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About dance and moving to music!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: What is your child's favourite song? Can they move in time to the beat? Listen and dance to songs at home. Be silly!</p>
