In school we are learning:

Our book for this half term is "A Christmas Carol" by Charles Dickens. We will be using this as the basis for our comprehension and writing lessons.

To begin the term we will be learning about halves and quarters. As the term progresses we will be counting in 2's, 3's and 5's.

Home learning opportunities:

Watch a version of "A Christmas Carol", there are lots of different versions including animations and musicals. Talk about the characters and the difference between Christmas today and a Victorian Christmas.

Home learning opportunities:

When eating pizza or other food talk about half and quarter portions. Practise telling the time to half past and quarter past the hour. Ask the children to count items that come in pairs, such as socks or shoes. Count how many there are using 2, 4, 6, 8, 10. Then count the items individually to show that the number of the items is the same.
