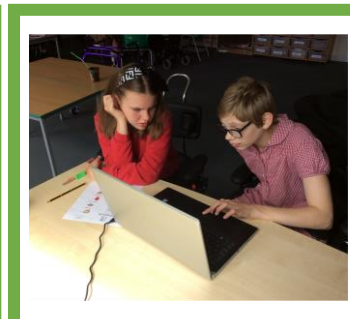


## Secondary Department Careers Week and Enterprise Summer Project

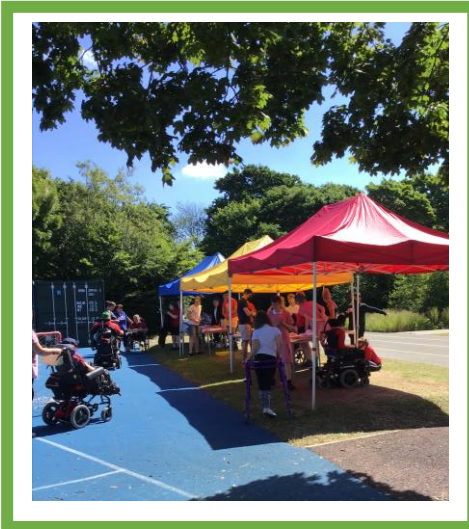


### Our Enterprise
