The Fundraising Team is pleased to share with you what has been achieved this year, and what our next fundraising mission is.

As you may know, following amazing donations and fundraising events in school, we took delivery of the Drivedeck in February. This is a power platform which can have lines laid on the floor to automatically follow, including junctions, or which, as the pupils progress, allows them to drive freely using switches or a joy stick.



#### Purchased from Smile Smart Technology Limited at a cost of £12, 605

The school's Physio team work with a group of children at a time, teaching them to independently use the device. Once they are confident, their sessions continue during class time.

By Christmas, 10 children will be competent in using the drivedeck, allowing them a real sense of independence. The next 5 children will be ready to start their physio sessions in January ©.
