











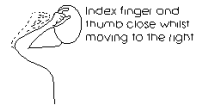


Our Learning Newsletter: Summer 2

<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: The story of 'Three Billy Goats Gruff', we will be retelling it in different ways such as role-play and engaging in a sensory story.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy reading for pleasure? Can they look at a picture in a book or listen to the story and answer questions about it? Can they retell, or help you retell, a familiar story?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About number, counting and exploring different objects and thinking about adding and subtracting numbers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy exploring different objects? Do they listen to you count or count themselves? Can they start to talk about adding or taking away objects?</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: How to have a caring and kind friendship. We are reading 'I love you (nearly always) by Anna Llenas and also 'How to be a lion' by Ed Vere. We are also learning to name our body parts</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Can we sing 'head, shoulders, knees and toes'? Am I a boy or girl? What about my family and friends? How can I be a kind friend?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About controlling devices, using movement, switches, remote controls.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Do you have any toys or games at home that your child has to do something to make it work? Can your child follow instructions to use a piece of technology?</p>
 <p style="text-align: center;">Life Skills</p> 	 <p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: About dressing and undressing, exploring choosing what clothes we like and having some fun dressing up!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy dressing up? How independently can they get dressed/undressed? Can they help you to dress/undress them eg put their arm in a sleeve or hold their foot out for their sock?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: We are banking upon good weather, this half term (fingers crossed) with a programme of outdoor play. We will be using soft play and PE equipment with an emphasis on the children building their play structures. This is ingenuity and physical play rolled into one.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Imagine a hot afternoon in the garden or park. When there, reinforce start/stop actions (this is a very important skill) but also balance and stretching. Go on, enjoy some outdoor yoga.</p>



Discovery Days



In our discovery days we will be focussing on humanities, science, RE and creative subjects.

For our RE this term we are learning about:

The Christian creation story, and why and how we should look after the world we live in.

Home learning opportunities:

Discuss with your child different ways to look after the world around them, for example, recycling, gardening, walking rather than driving. Have you read with them stories of creation from different religions? Can you discuss them?
