 <p>My Communication</p> 	 <p>My Cognition</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: All about Egypt. We are going on a magic carpet ride to Egypt in our sensory story and the pupils will be focusing on exploring different objects and activities around the story. We will also be looking at some key words/symbols for vocabulary too.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Explore different Egyptian experiences at home by mark making with sand, listening to Egyptian music or making a pyramid out of playdough.</p>	<p>In school we are learning: All about number. The pupils will be focusing on making choices to play different number games, activities and songs. In computing, we will be exploring number games and cause and effect activities with switches.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Explore singing number songs and playing games with a dice at home.</p>
 <p>My Body</p> 	 <p>My Community</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: All about music around the world. We are listening to different types of music and learning about timbre, exploring different types of sounds and instruments. We will be focusing on how we play different instruments, is there more than one way? We will also be thinking about how the different music makes us feel.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Listen to different world music at home and see which type of music your child prefers.</p>	<p>In school we are learning: All about places in our community and the world around us. We will be exploring our different environments in our school community and also experience different world communities through sensory stories.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Look at photos at home of different environments that you have explored together. If possible go and explore places in your local community, such as the shop or library.</p>
 <p>My Care and Independence</p> 	 <p>PSHE</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: All about interaction skills. The pupils will be focusing on their interaction skills with adults and their peers through social games. The children will also be continuing to focus on becoming more independent with their personal care needs, where possible.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Play different social games with each other at home, such as skittles, snakes and ladders or simple card games like snap.</p>	<p>In school we are learning: All about caring relationships. We will be exploring different relationships that are important to us and how they make us feel. We will also be exploring stories about different caring relationships.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Share stories about friendships and family at home, such as Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. Look at photos of people who are important to your child at home.</p>



Discovery Days



In our discovery days we will be focussing on humanities, science, RE and creative subjects.

For our Science this term we are learning about:

Light and dark, exploring light and dark toys in the sensory room and exploring shadows in our outside environments.

Home learning opportunities:

Go outside and look at the different shadows you can see. Change the lighting in a room in your house by turning the lights off and shining torches, can they make shadows with their hands/body parts.
